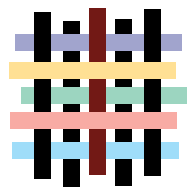

Under our pilot program, we are recruiting diverse volunteers with specialized language skills in Mandarin, Russian, Hindi, Vietnamese, Indonesian, Swahili, Somali, Hausa, Thai and Marshallese.

Some requirements that you need to meet

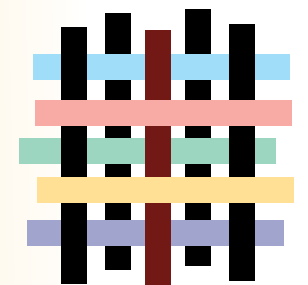
To become a Charter Member you will need to be a U.S. Citizen, 18 years or older, fluent in both your native language and English, and have a strong motivation to help your fellow citizens throughout the nation and world. Males are required to have met their Selective Service obligations.
